PHOENIX SERVICES

Phoenix Services upholds the requirements outlined by the Department of Human Services Office of Licensing, the Department of Child and Family Services and the Division of Services for People with Disabilities in providing the following services:

Professional Parent

Children, regardless of their disability, thrive, grow, and become contributing members of society when they're provided a safe, nurturing home environment with all parties involved participating together in supporting the child in his/her development.

Phoenix Services supports and actively assists in developing appropriate care for the child and facilitates open communication and positive relationships toward what is in the best interest of the child.

Respite Services

Phoenix Services teaches parents how to support disabled children through the often discouraging process of rehabilitation. Parents are offered breaks throughout the month with the support of our staff.

Children and families can best be supported when there is an opportunity for time off from the constant demands of caring for those children. Phoenix Services follows the most effective and up-to-date guidelines to hire and train the most competent respite care workers available to ensure the safety and well-being of each child served.

Family Support Services

People can best be supported when families have the resources and assistance necessary to keep the disabled family member in their own home.

Phoenix Services includes a wide variety of supports in the Family Support Services program. The services can be provided in or out of the person's home.

Phoenix provides one-on-one supports to the person and family in their own living, work and/or school environment. These supports may also include community activities as planned.

In addition to a variety of rehabilitative and companion services, Phoenix helps build "natural supports" in the surrounding

neighborhood and at the workplace (friends, supportive neighbors, co-workers, and local shop owners) for the person and the family.

Family Education Services

Families who are providing supports to their family members can benefit from expertise and experience of Phoenix professionals.

Supports can include instructions, supervision, and training to family members to understand and accommodate the special needs of their family member.

Summer Program (Day Service)

Phoenix Services can provide summer day programs on an individual basis as contracted with funding agencies.

Behavior Support Services

Behavior plans and supports are available as contracted at a Bachelor's or Master's Level.

Nurse Consultant

We have a nurse consultant who provides medical information and supports to children and families as contracted.
